PROVIDER TRAININGS

Health & Youth Development

This training introduces HIFY's perspective on youth and health. We explore youth development theory, the values underlying our work with youth, and how to apply an asset-based approach to youth health issues. Includes strategies for applying youth development in health care settings and youth agencies, as well as a chance to hear and share best practices. This training runs for 8 hours over the course of one day.

Latin@s, Health & Youth Development

This training introduces aspects of Latin American and Latina/o cultures that promote resilience, health, and can empower Latina/o youth to thrive in adulthood. This training is specifically designed for adults who work with Latina/o youth and are seeking to challenge traditional deficit-based approaches by practicing culturally appropriate youth development. The Health & Youth Development training is a pre-requisite for Latin@s, Health & Youth Development. This training runs for 6 hours over the course of one day.

Positive Sexuality & Youth

"Sex is dirty and nasty—save it for the one you love." Unfortunately, this is the message youth often receive. This training challenges this message by examining the concept of positive sexuality and exploring how it can strengthen our work with youth. We share tools for supporting youth as they make sexual decisions and develop healthy intimate relationships. This training runs for 14 hours over the course of two days.

Working With Lesbian, Gay, Bisexual, Transgender, Queer, Intersex, and Questioning (LGBTQIQ) Youth

Homophobia affects the well-being of all young people, whether they are LGBTQIQ or straight. Our interactive training gives you the knowledge and skills to create a safe place for all young people to explore their sexuality and gender regardless of how they identify. We discuss health concerns for LGBTQIQ youth and work on ways to develop our own ability to be allies. Includes basic information on adolescent identity development and transgender youth. This training runs for 14 hours over the course of 2 days.

Substance Use & Youth

More than half of all high school students have experimented with illicit substances, so programs that serve youth must be equipped with skills for addressing this issue. Simplistic messages such as "Just Say No" do not address the real needs or underlying issues youth have when making decisions about substance use. This training provides an overview of youth substance use and harm reduction. We discuss harm reduction theory, analyze messages that youth receive about drugs, and explore the context in which youth make decisions about substance use. This training runs for 14 hours over the course of 2 days.

All Oakland trainings will be held at 685 14th Street; a short walk from the 12th Street Oakland City Center BART stop.

Location for San Francisco trainings is 1550 Bryant Street, 11th Floor, a short walk/bus ride from 16th Street BART stop.
